Subject: Criminal Record and Vulnerable Sector Check

Police criminal record checks are a necessary qualification for all persons wishing to volunteer with the Charlotte County Minor Hockey Association (CCMHA) and having access to players in the dressing room.

These checks will be conducted on all persons volunteering for the first time in the CCMHA or when re-volunteering after a break of continuity in volunteering and subsequently at three (3) year intervals.

Hockey New Brunswick requires that all coaches, assistant coaches, managers, trainers and volunteers in any capacity who are involved in the upcoming season must provide a check that includes "vulnerable sectors". This check is more extensive and will help ensure our children are in a safe environment.

A failure to comply with this requirement or any unsatisfactory results will result in removal from the program.
